

- 28.5% wanted to bring justice to perpetrator



Phony Banking Schemes

- Find your bank's phone number online or on a statement to ensure you're calling the bank and not a scammer.
- Be cautious of links sent via text.
- Never give personal information to unsolicited callers.
- Ignore instructions to text "STOP" or "NO" to prevent future texts.
- If you got a phishing text message, forward it to SPAM (7726).



Government Imposters



The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) is the government agency that collects federal taxes.

Scammers pretend to be IRS officials to get you to send them money.

The IRS won't text you about your refund.

It's a scam.

Emergency & Urgency Scams



What To Do If You Get a Call About a Family Emergency

Resist the pressure to send money immediately. Hang up!

Then:

Call or message the family member or friend who (supposedly) contacted you.

OR

Call someone else in your family or circle of friends, even if the caller said to keep it a secret.

Favor for a Friend Scam




In this new con, a scammer poses as a friend asking for a simple favor. These emails are so convincing that BBB staff almost fell for it!

Protect yourself from this con

Reach out to your friend directly.

Use gift cards wisely. Never do business with anyone who insists on payment with gift cards.
